WHAT IS CLUB 45?

Preteen Club 45 is an opportunity for preteens to learn about leadership, participate in projects that serve others and have fun with peers.

WHO SHOULD JOIN?

Anyone in grades 4 and 5, looking to have fun, learn and serve others.

THE MISSION

Preteen Club 45 gives preteens grades 4 & 5 an opportunity to gain real-life, hands-on leadership experience through Volunteer Opportunities and Trainings at FBC Leesburg, Planning and Executing Events (Trunk or Treat, Shop4Free and more), Weekend Leadership Training as well as scheduled Lunch and Learn events.

One of the primary service opportunities is during the 11:00am Kidz Church hour. Kids in Preteen Club 45 will learn how to teach, lead worship, run technology and serve others.

VOLUNTEERING

Under the supervision of FBC Leesburg staff and volunteers, preteens discover ways to grow closer to Christ through service to others.

Preteen Leaders will have the opportunity to be trained and volunteer in a variety of different ministry areas on Sunday mornings. Some areas include but are not limited to Praise Team, Tech Team, Welcoming Team, Food Service, etc.

Preteens will go through a general orientation and then go through an area specific training. They can sign-up for specific days. Their duties will be ones that challenge them to use the skills they learn during Lunch & Learn Trainings.

WHAT ARE THE GOALS/EXPECTATIONS?

GOALS

- **PURPOSE** – for each preteen to understand their purpose...to know God and bring Him glory.
- **RELATIONSHIP DEVELOPMENT** – for each preteen to develop a stronger relationship with Christ, families, the leaders and friends.
- **SPIRITUAL GROWTH** – for each preteen to understand the mentality and attitude with which Christ wants him or her to serve.
- **SKILLS** – for each preteen to develop skills in leadership and service while exploring ministry opportunities.

EXPECTATIONS

- **PRIORITY** – each preteen leader is expected to make their relationship with Christ and their family the top priority in their lives.
- **ATTENDANCE** – each preteen leader is expected to be an active part of the church through attendance – participating in as many Wednesday and Sunday activities as possible. The off campus “Adventure Activities/Trips” are not mandatory but do help in creating stronger team cohesion.
- **COMMITTED and RELIABLE** – each preteen is expected to be committed to attend the service for which they are scheduled to serve, letting Pastor Skipper know at least one week in advance when they are not able to serve – except in cases of emergencies, of course!
- **TRAINING** – each preteen is expected to attend Lunch & Learns as often as possible.
- **BE AN EXAMPLE** – each preteen is expected to set an example during services by participating in Worship, inviting and welcoming new kids, contributing to small group discussions, and having a positive attitude.
